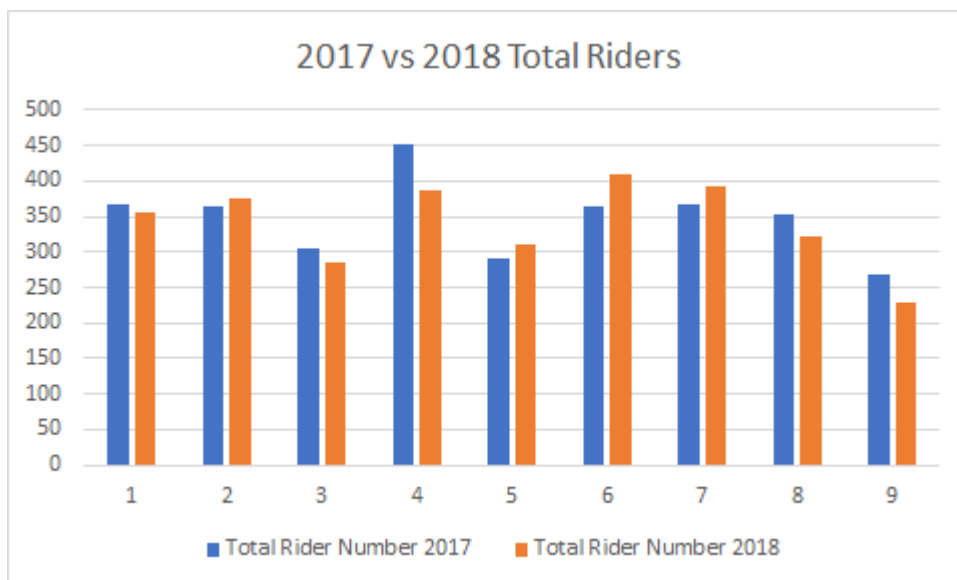


BMX NORTH ANNUAL REPORT

- The North BMX Region has had another fantastic year.
- Expert rider participation has increased due to new regional rule of 5 novice rounds, to help create BMX race pathway structure. Allowing riders to gain experience at club level, before progressing to regional level
- Race levies paid by North Region to British Cycling for 2018 = £5,811.50, not including the £1 administration fee per rider, per race.
- More BMX commissaires have been trained and regularly volunteer at events, 5 new trainees and 1 newly qualified Regional Commissaire.
- 255 riders competed at 6 or more North regional BMX races, 377 riders competed at 5 or more North regional BMX races, to qualify for the British BMX Championships (the largest number for the North).
- This year the British Championships are being held in the North at Blackpool BMX Club, it is anticipated that this year will be the highest number of North riders competing in recent history.
