Key Responsibilities:

Elected at a Regional Council meeting by Regional Council and other Board members, to ensure the board fulfils its responsibilities to the region's membership.

Competence/Experience

- Be a member of British Cycling and be in either a club/team or Private member within the NW Region.
- Understanding and acceptance of the responsibilities and liabilities of the Region
- Commitment to British Cycling and the Region's objectives, aims and values and willingness to devote time to carry out responsibilities.
- A sound knowledge of the BC handbook & Governance.
- Good communication and interpersonal skills and the ability to respect the confidences of colleagues.

Main duties

- Assist to enable the Board fulfils their responsibilities for the overall governance and strategic direction of the Region.
- Elected members will at the first meeting following the AGM as applicable, be appointed with specific duties in addition to the responsibilities as a board member, these may //include:- Appointment of Vice-Chair (Safeguarding & Welfare Officer), Diversity & Inclusion, Youth Team Co-ordinator & Publicity & Media (including website content)
- Attend approximately 6-8 Regional Board meetings per year and workgroup meetings as required.
- Hold responsibility for a workgroup and carry out other specific duties as agreed with/ by the Board.
- Attend Regional AGM & Regional Council meeting in the capacity of representing your club/team or as a private member.
- Reasonable expenses incurred as part of the role will be reimbursed by the Region.
